NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the power conferred by clause (VI) of Sub Section (9) of Section 86 of the Bengal Excise Act, 1909 (Ben. Act. V of 1909) read with Paragraph 14 of the Order Published with Notification No. 596 SR dated 30.3.1945, as subsequently amended, I, the Excise Commissioner, West Bengal do hereby order that notwithstanding anything contained in other rules and orders in this behalf all licenses as mentioned in Rule 4 of the West Bengal Excise (selection of New sites and Grant of License for Retail sale of Liquor and certain other intoxicants) Rules, 2003, as amended will function as per the following schedule :-

1) Maha Astami on 04.10.2011 (Tuesday)

a) All the F.L. 'OFF'/'ON' Shops C.S. Off/ON Shops, Hotels with Bars (Below 3 Star Category) in the entire territorial jurisdiction of Kolkata Municipal Corporation and within the territorial jurisdiction of Bidhan Nagar Municipality shall ~~closed till 3 P.M. and function thereafter till normal closing hours. All other retail shops shall remain closed throughout the day.~~

b) All retail Excise Shops in the rest of the State shall remain closed throughout the day.

c) Bars in Clubs, Hotel-Cum-Bars (with 3 Star and above) throughout the State will function normally.

2) Vijaya Dashami on 06.10.2011 (Thursday)

a) All F.L. 'ON' Shops, Hotel-Cum-Bars (Below 3 Star Category) Restaurant-cum-Bars in the entire territorial jurisdiction of Kolkata Municipal Corporation and within the territorial jurisdiction of Bidhan Nagar Municipality will function as usual. F.L. 'OFF' & C.S. 'OFF' and/or 'ON' Shops in the said locality shall remain closed from 4.00 P.M. onwards and all other retail shops shall remain closed throughout the day.

b) F.L. 'OFF' and C.S. 'OFF' and/or 'ON' shops in the rest of the State shall remain closed from 4.00 P.M. onwards. All other retail shops shall remain closed throughout the day.

c) Bars in Clubs, Hotel-cum-Bars (with 3 Star and above) throughout the State will function normally.

3) Kali Pujā on 26.10.2011 (Wednesday)

a) All F.L. 'ON' Shops, Restaurant-cum-Bars, Hotels with Bars (Below 3 Star Category) in the entire territorial Jurisdiction of Kolkata Municipal Corporation and within the territorial Jurisdiction of Bidhan Nagar Municipality will function as usual. F.L. 'OFF' and C.S. 'OFF' and/or 'ON' Shops in the said localities shall remain closed from 4.00 P.M. onwards. All other retail shops shall remain closed throughout the day.

b) F.L. 'OFF' and C.S. 'OFF' and/or 'ON' Shops in the rest of the State shall remain closed from 4.00 P.M. onwards. All other retail shops shall remain closed throughout the day.

c) Bars in Clubs, Hotel-cum-Bars (with 3 Star & above) throughout the State will function normally.



N O T I F I C A T I O N

In exercise of power conferred under sub-rule (VI) of Clause 9 of Section 86 of the Bengal Excise Act, 1909 (Ben Act V of 1909) as delegated to the Excise Commissioner, West Bengal vide sub-para (3) of paragraph 14 of the consolidated orders made under provisions of the Bengal Excise Act, 1909 and published under Notification No. 596 SR dated 30.03.1915 as amended upto date, I, the Excise Commissioner, West Bengal do hereby order that notwithstanding any thing contained in any other rules or notification in this behalf, all licensed premises for the retail sale of liquor throughout the State, will operate in the following manner on the occasion of the Muharram and the Holi festival.

- 1) On the occasion of Muharram all Excise Shops throughout the State will remain closed on 01.03.04 & 02.03.04 except the shops located in Kolkata Municipal Corporation area, Howrah Municipal Corporation area and Bidhannagar Municipality area where shops will remain open till 16.00 hrs. on 01.03.04 and from 16.00 hrs. till normal working hours on 02.03.04.
- 2) All licensed premises for retail sale of Foreign Liquor as mentioned below shall remain open throughout the State beyond 15.00 hrs. to normal working hours on 06.03.04, the day on which Doljatra Festival will be observed :-
 - a) for consumption 'on' the premises ;
 - b) for consumption in any restaurant and in the attached bar or bars, if any ;
 - c) for consumption in any hotel and in the attached bar or bars, if any ;
 - d) for consumption in any hotel-cum-restaurant and in the attached bar or bars, if any ;
 - e) for consumption in any theatre, club, dakhungalow, tourist lodge, customs airport or any other places of public resort and entertainment and in the attached bar or bars, if any ;
- 3) Bars attached to 3 star and above hotels will function normally irrespective of the above order on the occasion of Muharram and Holi festival on 01.03.04, 02.03.04 and 06.03.04.
